Transportation: Chicago area campers have the option to take chartered buses to and from camp, or parents may drive campers to and from camp. Bus transportation is \$75 each way and includes shipment of luggage.

Personal Charge Account: There is a Personal Charge Account which is \$100 for 4 weeks (\$125 for grades 9-11) and \$200 for the full session (\$225 for grades 9-11). The account covers canteen, laundry, sundries and spending money for trips.

PAYMENT AND CANCELLATION

PAYMENT AND CANCELLATION TERMS FOR CAMPER WHO ARE NOT ENROLLED IN CAMPER ASSURANCE PROGRAM (CAP):

Payment terms are a **\$1500 deposit** (includes \$100 non-refundable application fee) to accompany enrollment form; Balance due April 30, 2010. All tuition and fees are fully refundable (less the \$100 application fee) prior to **December 15, 2009**. Thereafter, there will be a cancellation fee of \$1000 from December 16 to March 31; \$2000 from April 1 to April 30; and \$3500 from May 1 to June 1. After June 1, no payment will be refunded.

Changes from 8 to 4 week enrollment must be made by December 1, 2009 to avoid a \$300 surcharge. All cancellations must be in writing.

PAYMENT AND CANCELLATION TERMS FOR CAMPER ENROLLED IN CAMPER ASSURANCE PROGRAM (CAP):

Payment terms are a **\$1500 deposit** (includes \$100 non-refundable application fee) to accompany enrollment form; Balance due April 30, 2010. Parents will receive a refund or credit for all monies based on when the cancellation is received. For cancellations received prior to January 1, 2010 Parent will receive a full refund of all payments (including the \$100 application fee). For cancellations received between January 1, 2010 and March 14, 2010, 10% of Camp tuition will be retained by Camp as a credit against a future Camp session and all additional payments except the CAP fee will be refunded. For cancellations received between March 15, 2010 and June 1, 2010, 25% of the Camp tuition will be retained by Camp as a credit against a future Camp session. For cancellations received after June 1, 2010, 50% of tuition will be retained by Camp as a credit against future Camp session and all additional payments will be refunded. If Camper needs to leave Camp early, the unused portion of the Camp tuition will be retained as a credit by Camp for a future Camp session. CAP is intended to protect the Camp investment should Parent or Camper need to cancel for any personal reason (including personal choice). Participants in CAP do not need a specific reason to receive the benefits of CAP. However, in order to protect the Camp for future generations, the Camp reserves the right to issue credits in lieu of scheduled refunds in the unlikely event of an Act of God, War, Terrorism, Civil Unrest, or any other non-personal situation that, in the Camp's sole judgment, could lead to significant cancellations that would have a negative financial impact on the future of the Camp.

If you pay by check, your check will be converted into a one-time electronic debit from the bank account on which your check is drawn.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. RULES AND REGULATIONS:** The camper ("Camper") and parent(s) ("Parent") agree to abide by all of the rules and regulations established by Greenwoods Camp for Boys and Lake of the Woods Camp for Girls ("Camp") including, without limitation, those relating to enrollment and withdrawal of campers and visitation.
- 2. DISMISSAL OF CAMPER:** The Camp reserves the right to dismiss, in its sole discretion, any Camper whose condition, conduct, influence or behavior is deemed unsatisfactory or detrimental to the best interests of the Camp or his/her fellow campers or who violates camp rules and regulations, in which case no refunds will be made.
- 3. MEDICAL CARE:** Medical care provided by the Camp nurse is included in the tuition. Parent grants Camp permission to utilize medical treatment (including dental and orthodonture) outside of Camp should the Camp Director(s) ("Director") deem such treatment necessary for Camper's well being. Should it be necessary for the well being of the Camper to use outside medical care, all expenses involved will be paid by Parent. In addition, any dental, orthodontic, or optical work will be paid by Parent.
- 4. TRANSPORTATION:** Chicago area campers have the option to take chartered buses to and from camp, or parents may drive campers to and from camp. Bus transportation is \$75 each way and includes luggage.
- 5. LATE ARRIVAL / EARLY DEPARTURE:** No allowance or reduction will be made for late arrival or early departure of Camper.
- 6. PERMISSION TO PARTICIPATE:** Parent grants Camper permission to participate in all Camp activities, excursions, and special outings and understands that accidents and injuries may occur in the natural course of participation in such activities.
- 7. IMAGES, ETC:** Permission is hereby given for Camp to use in promoting the Camp and in other ventures directly relating to the Camp (i) digital, photographic, video, and audio images or likenesses of camper; and (ii) statements, articles, names, music, art, photographs, audio recordings, films and videos created by Camper or originating from Camp or from a Camp-related activity.
- 8. BELONGINGS:** Camp is not responsible for Camper's belongings or equipment while in transit or at Camp.
- 9. COLLECTION:** If tuition or fees are not paid in full for Camper, Parent will be liable for all costs of collection, including attorney's fees.
- 10. DISPUTES:** All claims or disputes asserted by Camper or Parent against the Camp and arising from or related to this Agreement shall be brought and maintained in the courts of the State of Michigan (Van Buren County), and Parent expressly submits to the jurisdiction of such courts. The substantive law of the State of Michigan will govern such disputes without regard to conflict of law rules. Any individual bringing legal action against Camp, which action is decided in favor of Camp, will be responsible for all legal fees, court costs and out-of-pocket expenses of Camp, its owners and employees.
