
Dear Campers,

Q. What happens if I get homesick at camp?

A. Everyone misses home sometimes, and that is very normal! Even your counselors and friends at camp might miss certain things from home. All of your counselors and directors at camp are there to make sure we do whatever we can to help you feel better and get your mind off of feeling homesick. You should tell your counselors whenever you are feeling down, and they will help you find a way to have fun even though you are missing home.
