

CAMPER ASSURANCE PROGRAM (CAP)

What if... Your child is sick or injured or is unable to attend camp for ANY reason?

Or if... Your child receives a "once-in-a-lifetime" opportunity for next summer, or simply decides to try something different?

Or if... A family emergency or personal financial situation makes it imprudent or impossible for your child to go to camp?

Or if... Your child decides he or she is not ready to attend overnight camp this summer?

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Are my payments really protected if my child cancels without a good reason?

Yes. You do not need to give us a reason to cancel under CAP. The only requirement is that you send us a written cancellation before camp opens. Depending on when you cancel, a portion of your payments will be retained as a credit for a future camp session for your child or a sibling, and the remainder will be refunded.

Why would I choose CAP?

With CAP you can cancel for any reason and 100% of your payments are protected. In addition, if your child needs to leave camp early, the unused portion of your camp fee will be retained as a credit that can be used toward tuition another summer or transferred to an immediate family member.

Can I sign up for the CAP program at any time?

No. You MUST sign up and pay for CAP at the same time you enroll your child. If you do not sign up for CAP and find it necessary to cancel, you will be subject to the standard cancellation penalties outlined during registration.

Will I get 100% of my money back if I enroll in CAP and need to cancel?

Below outlines how your payments are protected if you are enrolled in CAP and need to cancel:

CAP REFUND & CANCELLATION POLICIES

- Cancellations on or before December 1, 2025 will result in a full refund of payments less the CAP fee of \$250 or \$350.
- Cancellations between December 2, 2025 and March 14, 2026, 10% of the total camp tuition will be retained by Camp as a credit against a future Camp session, and excluding the CAP fee, any other monies will be refunded.
- Cancellations between March 15, 2026 and May 31, 2026, 25% of the total Camp tuition will be retained by Camp as a credit against a future Camp session, and excluding the CAP fee, any other monies will be refunded.
- Cancellations after June 1, 2026, 50% of the total Camp tuition will be retained by Camp as a credit against a future Camp session, and excluding the CAP fee, any other monies will be refunded.
- If a Camper needs to leave Camp early, the unused portion of the Camp tuition, which will be prorated, will be retained as a credit by Camp for a future Camp session. CAP is intended to protect the Camp investment should a Parent or Camper need to cancel for any personal reason (including personal choice).

PAYMENT TERMS

- The fee for CAP is \$250 for 2 or 4 week sessions and is non-refundable.
- The fee for CAP is \$350 for 8 weeks and is non-refundable.
- An \$850 deposit for 2-week campers, a \$1,500 deposit for 4-week campers, and a \$2,000 deposit for Full Session campers
 (all deposits include a \$200 non-refundable application fee) to accompany the application. Deposit is NOT processed until
 availability is confirmed.
- An additional tuition installment of \$1,000 is due February 1, 2026 for each camper. Final tuition balance is due April 30, 2026.
- Payment plans are available. All tuition must be paid in full prior to camper arrival at camp.
- Final tuition balance is due April 30, 2026.

Participants in CAP do not need a specific reason to receive the benefits of CAP. The Camp reserves the right to issue credits in lieu of scheduled refunds in the unlikely event of an Act of God, War, Terrorism, Civil Unrest, Communicable Disease, or any other non-personal situation that, in the Camp's sole judgment, could lead to significant cancellations that would have a negative financial impact on the future of the Camp.
