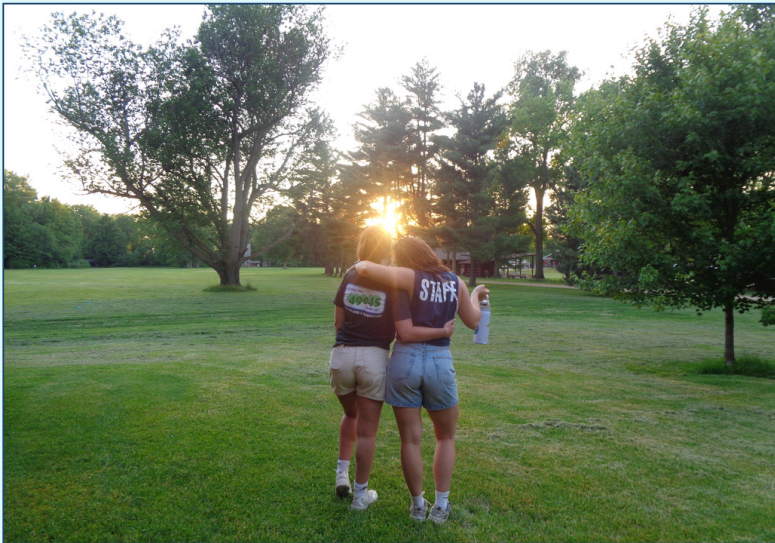

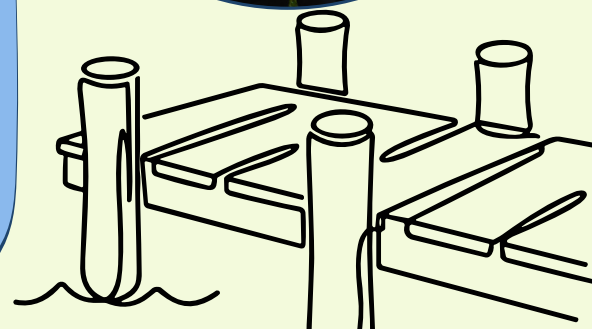
What will you challenge yourself with this summer?
